

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited to inform you that, as part of our On the Farm topic next half term, we have arranged a trip to White Post Farm on **Monday, 20th April 2026**.

This will be a fantastic opportunity for the children to explore farm life and learn more about animals and how a working farm operates. During the visit, the children will take part in a range of engaging activities, including:

- A guided tour of the animals, including an animal handling session where children can learn about and interact with them
- A tractor and trailer ride, accompanied by a farm talk tailored specifically to our group
- Access to the farm's more exotic animals, including armadillos, birds of prey, wallabies, and more
- Time to enjoy the outdoor play area

To cover the cost of coach travel and admission, we kindly request a contribution of £22.64 per child. Please note that the trip may not be able to go ahead if insufficient contributions are received.

Payments can be made via ParentPay, and we ask that all contributions are completed by Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April.

To support families, an instalment plan is available, allowing the cost to be spread over time. Please contact the school office if this is something you need to discuss.

As always, we welcome parent volunteers to join us. To ensure fairness, names will be selected at random. If you would like to volunteer, please fill out the GoogleForm which will be sent via an Arbor in app message. Please note that, while staff retain overall responsibility, volunteers will be asked to supervise a small group of up to five children.

We are confident that this trip will be both enjoyable and educational, enriching the children's learning as part of our On the Farm topic.
