The Phonics Screening Check is a statutory assessment that all Year 1 children in England complete in June. It plays a vital role in identifying how well children are progressing with their phonics knowledge, which underpins early reading development.

The purpose of the meeting is to ensure you have a clear understanding of:

- ☑ What the Phonics Screening Check involves
- ☑ How it is administered in school
- ☑ What your child will be expected to do
- ☑ How you can best support your child at home in the lead-up to the check

We strongly encourage at least one parent or carer to attend, as the information shared will directly support your child's preparation and confidence. Your engagement at this stage can make a significant difference to their progress and achievement.
