Swimming Lessons – Years 4

Dear Parent/Carers,

Swimming is a compulsory part of the primary physical education curriculum and lessons begin next term for Year 4.

Year 4 will attend swimming lessons every **Friday morning** from Friday 22nd April up until the end of the school year.

Our school swimming lessons take place at Swimstars & Dolphins at Quest Park. We have worked with Swimstars & Dolphins, the Local Authority, our Trust and Swim England to ensure that our provider is COVID-safe. The additional arrangements in place are in line with the school's measures and risk assessment, including no one with symptoms admitted to the facilities and additional cleaning between all bubbles.

Swimming kit

On swimming days, kit and a towel need to be brought to school in a named, separate bag. Children without the correct swimming kit will still attend the sessions and observe from the side. The pool's requirements for swimming kit are as follows:

- Boy: fitted swim shorts/trunks not beach shorts
- Girls: full swimming costume not a bikini
- Goggles and swim hats are optional
- Long hair needs to be tied up
- No jewellery
- No deodorant or body sprays
- Toenails and fingernails should not be painted.

Please advise us of any medical conditions that we are not already aware of that may affect your child so we can liaise with the relevant medical practitioner. If your child is unable to take part in the swimming lessons due to medical reasons, please provide a valid medical certificate to your child's class teacher or the school main office.
