Increase in Price of School Dinners

Dear Parent/Carer,

We had previously planned to increase the cost of a school meal to £2.50 from 1st April 2022 but due to the current financial situation affecting many families we made the decision to defer the increase.

Unfortunately, we are now unable to defer this decision any longer. Due to the increased costs facing school, a Trust decision has been taken to increase the cost from September 2022. After the Summer holidays the price for children in Key Stage 2 (Year 3 and above) will increase to £2.50 a day (or £12.50 a week). This will also apply to the children in Nursery who access the wraparound lunchtime provision.

It is also important to note that for children moving into Year 3 in September, the Universal Infant Free School Meals entitlement will cease and all children wishing to continue to take school meals will have to start paying for meals at this new rate.

I also wanted to take the opportunity to politely remind all parents that dinner monies must be paid for in advance via the Parent Pay system.
