### **Meet the Teacher Sessions**

If you are attending an afternoon session, please arrive at the session start time and go to your child's classroom door/external door where they usually exit. You only need to attend one of the sessions and don't need to sign up.

During the summer term, we will also offer a more traditional, in-person learning conference to discuss progress and view your child's work. The dates for these will be shared at the start of the new term.
