Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our science unit for the summer term, we have arranged for all Year 3 pupils to visit Eureka Museum, Halifax on **Tuesday 19th May 2026**.

Children will depart school via coach at approximately 9am and should arrive back at school for 3:15pm. The children will have the opportunity to have a tour around the museum, exploring a wide variety of interactive exhibits, and gain a further insight into what they have been learning in school. The museum will also be delivering a light and sound science show.

All children will be required to bring a packed lunch from home (no cans, glass bottles or sweets) however, should your child be entitled to benefit related free school meals, you will have the option to order a free school packed lunch. School packed lunches consist of a cheese sandwich, 1 piece of fruit and a small piece of cake. All pupils will be required to bring a water bottle. Please contact the school office if you would like to order a free school meal packed lunch for your child.

To ensure that the trip can go ahead, we are requesting a contribution of £23.10, which includes entrance fees, the science show, and transport costs. Payments can be made online via ParentPay.

If we do not receive enough contributions, we will be required to cancel the visit.
