Dear Parents/Carers

I would once again like to start this letter by thanking you for your support that you continue to give to your children, your academy/school and to the Trust.

As you know we welcomed our three new schools to the Trust on 1st April, Bentley High Street, Rosedale Primary and Willow Primary and I cannot tell you how excited we are that they are now part of our Exceed family, collaboratively working together to achieve the very best opportunities for our pupils whilst on their learning journey with us.
